Morning tea and lunches: Students bring their own morning tea and lunches to school every day. We don't have microwave for students to use. Please bring sandwiches or food that doesn't need to be heated. Some classes have brain food break after the first block. We have sausage sizzle on Tuesday (\$2/a sausage) and Sushi order on Thursday. We are a cashless school, all orders are done online through the myKindo app.

Uniform for short term students: We require all our international students to wear our school uniform so that they can immerse themselves into the community.

Sunhat policy: The UV index is very high in NZ. We have a very strict sunhat policy at school for two summer terms 1 and 4. The rule is no hat, no play. We have sunscreen in all classrooms for students to use. You can bring your own hat. The colour is dark blue.
