Titirangi Road, Titirangi

Our role is to ensure that people can move around the city easily and safely. We carry out regular maintenance and repair work on the network so they can do this in an easy and efficient manner.

The work we're doing

We're doing this work to maintain and improve your neighbourhood and to keep our communities safe. The drawings overleaf show where we'll be working.

Footpath Kerb and Channel Works: The footpath that needs repairing is excavated and then is backfilled, compacted, and boxed up with timber. Once this is completed, concrete is poured, and berms and carriageways are then reinstated.

We'll do our best to start the work on time. Factors such as wet weather could mean a delayed start. If the delay is significant, we'll notify you.

Traffic management and Detours

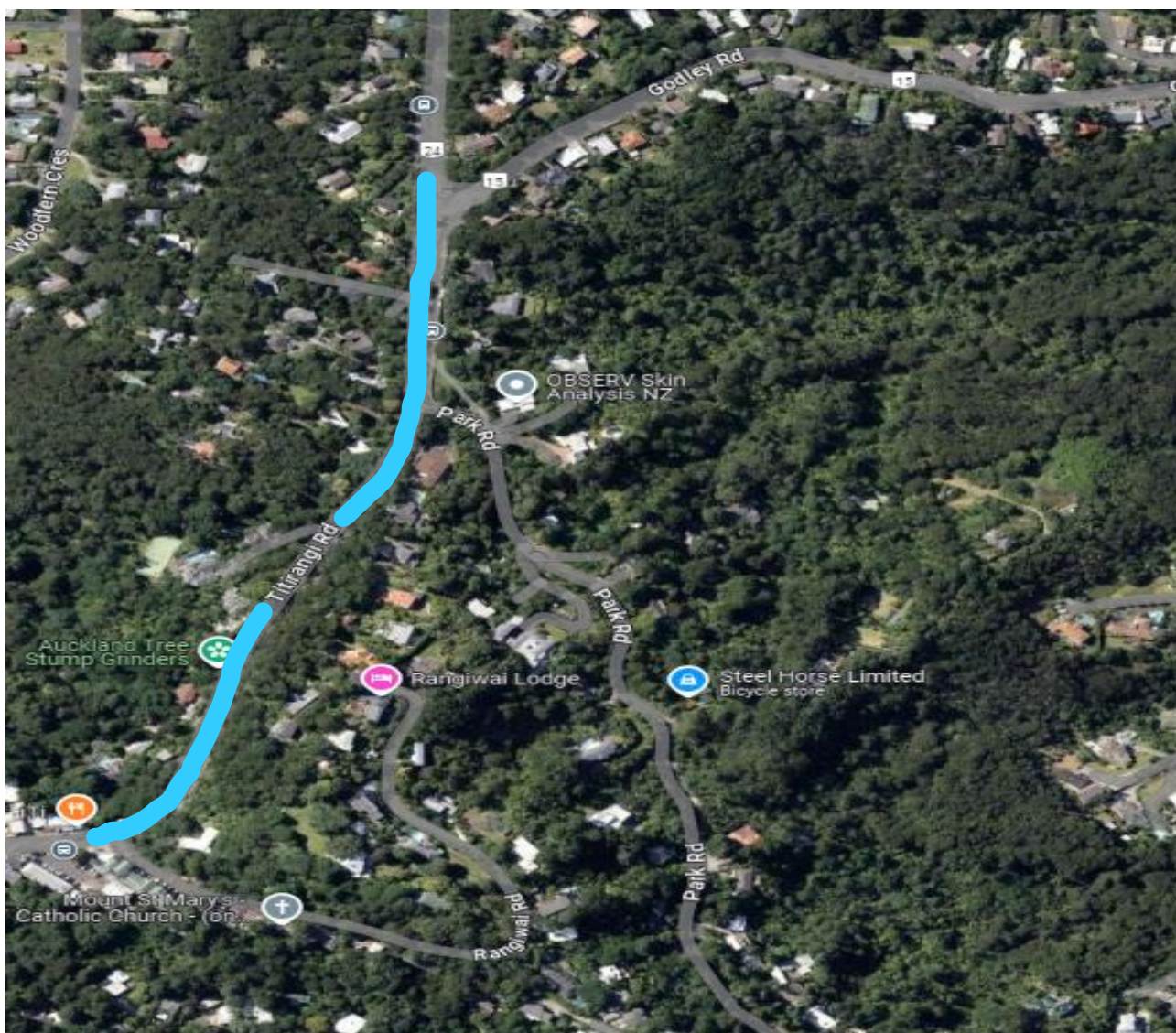
The work will be done in 3 stages.

You'll need to reduce your speed when you're driving through the area. Please follow all signs, light signals, and traffic directions.

On-street parking will be limited while we carry out the work. You may need to either park on your property or on a side road and walk to your property.

Temporary vehicle access to your property will be maintained, however, this access won't be available on the day of concrete pours and whilst the concrete cures. Residents will be contacted 24 hours prior to the concrete pours to help accommodate any specific needs.
