## **COVID-19**

As the government starts changing the COVID-19 traffic light framework, we are still in Red and have decided to retain and continue with our parent protocols until further notice. The start and end of day times for our students will remain. School gates will open at 8:30am, students (only) can enter, heading to the classroom to leave their bags and play till 8:50am. At 8:50am school starts.

Well done to the students who are arriving to school on time for the day's learning. Your support in getting your children to school on time is greatly appreciated.

Juniors Y1-Y2 are released from their classroom at 2.40pm and escorted to their already waiting parents/caregivers (in the junior teacher carpark). Once you have your children, we ask that you leave the area asap in order that the Year 3 parents/caregivers can gather to wait for the 2.55pm bell time.

Thank you for continuing to let us know of positive cases in your household. We have seen an increase in the number of positive cases this week and we are mindful that we could get more cases over the weeks to come. This week we had 28 positive cases and our total positive cases for the last 5 weeks is 101.
