

GREEN NOTE Violin

We are delighted to announce a long term musical collaboration between Green Bay High School and Green Bay School called Green Note.

Our first goal is to build a symphony orchestra across our school community and to bring that dream to life, we need a string section.

Beginning this Term, Green Note are offering violin lessons at Green Bay School for Year 3-8 students during class time on a Friday between 9:30am and 12:30am.

We are incredibly lucky to have secured the services of Violin teacher Amelia Owens. Amelia has played and performed extensively for most of her life, and believes that learning an instrument is an important and enriching life-skill. She has 10 years of experience as a Suzuki Violin teacher and looks forward to sharing the joy of music with your children.

Cost: One on one lessons will be weekly at \$30 per ½ hour lesson. Instrument hireage will be \$108 for the remainder of the year. We would require commitment to lessons for a minimum of two Terms, and fees would be payable per Term in advance, with no refunds or makeups for missed lessons on the students' part.

Additionally, students will participate in a string ensemble which will meet and perform as the year progresses.

We have 6 lesson slots, so be quick as priority will be given to students whose intention is to attend Green Bay High School in the future.

This is a once in a lifetime opportunity for your child to become involved in a high quality music programme, with its many widely known benefits including superior academic development and enhanced wellbeing.
